CALL FOR GRANTS FOR R&D PROJECTS AND INSTITUTIONS

2 Scientific Initiation Studentships

A call is open for (2) Research Grants, within the scope of the KIC InnoEnergy project (1018P.05452), for the International Mobility and Partnerships Office, Instituto Superior Técnico, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Organizational Engineering and Management / International Affairs

Admission requirements: the candidate must be enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's degree in an area that may be related to the proposed work plan.

Work plan: Collaboration in the implementation and management of the KIC Innoenergy project, as well as other projects under the responsibility of the International Mobility and Partnerships Office (NMPI). Support in preparing and submitting applications for international projects, analyzing protocols and managing exchange procedures, within the scope of the Office's activities. Development and implementation of strategies to publicize and disseminate NMPI initiatives and projects. Research and application of innovative approaches to promoting international cooperation.

Applicable legislation and regulations: Law no. 40/2004, of August 18 (*Estatuto do Bolseiro de Investigação Científica*), as amended by Decree-Law no. 123/2019, of August 28; IST Regulation of Scientific Research Fellowships, available on https://drh.tecnico.ulisboa.pt/files/sites/45/despacho_8532_regulamento_bolsas.pdf

Place of work: The work will be carried out at the International Mobility and Partnerships Office on the Alameda Campus of the Instituto Superior Técnico, under the supervision of coordinator Ana Rita Martins Fortunato.

Duration of Grant(s): Each grant will last for 12 months, starting in September 2025. The grant contract cannot be renewed.

Monthly maintenance allowance: The grant amount corresponds to 651,12€, and the method of payment is by bank transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used will be as follows:

1. Assessment of the candidate's curriculum and motivation, using the following criteria and scoring (total score is 20 points), requiring a Bachelor's or Master's degree in areas relevant to the grant;
2. Individual interview. If the jury deems it appropriate, interviews will be necessary to complement the candidates' curricula and motivation. In this case, the curriculum evaluation and motivation will have a weight of 60% and the interview will weigh 40%, being evaluated from 0 to 20 points.

Composition of selection panel: Ana Rita Martins Fortunato (President); Luís Filipe Almeida Moreira (Member); Ricardo Jorge da Cunha Pinto (Member)

How the results will be publicized/notified: All candidates will be notified by e-mail of the final results of the assessment.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision, or an appeal to the President of IST, within 15 working days counted from the respective notification.

Call deadline and form of submission: The call is open from July 30 until August 5, 2025.
