## NOTICE FOR THE AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIPS UNDER R&D PROJECTS AND INSTITUTIONS

## **Research Initiation Grant**

Applications are open for (1) research initiation Grant to carry out professional activities in the domain of Library, Culture and Museums, financed by IST in the following conditions:

Scientific field: Library and Information Sciences

Admission requirements: Must be enrolled in a Master's programme in the field of Library and Information Sciences.

## Workplan:

- Assist in the identification, evaluation and dissemination of digital resources within databases and library information systems like koha (version 16.11) and platforms like EBSCO Discovery service;
- Contribute to open science initiatives, including repository administration, scientific data management and the implementation of open access policies, with particular emphasis on the institutional repository;
- Implement practices for the processing, description and curation of information in multiple formats, with a focus on handling digital content and metadata;
- conduct training sessions aimed at empowering users in the domain of information literacy, promoting critical and independent use of information resources;
- Manage and promote content in Web 2.0 and Web 3.0 environments, fostering information presence and online interaction;
- Develop cultural activities such as exhibitions, seminars, clubs, workshops and contests, as well as, curate and promote cultural initiatives both internal and external to Instituto Superior Técnico (IST).

**Legislation and Regulations:** Law No. 40/2004 of August 18<sup>th</sup>, establishing the Statute of the Scientific Research Fellow, as currently amended; IST Regulation for Scientific Research Fellowships, available on https://drh.tecnico.ulisboa.pt/files/sites/45/despacho 8532 regulamento bolsas.pdf

**Workplace:** The work will be carried out at the Library of Instituto Superior Técnico (Campus Alameda), under the scientific guidance of PhD Isabel Pacheco Marques Vaz Marcos

**Duration:** The research fellowship will have the duration of 12 months, expected to begin in September 2025. The fellowship contract is non-renewable.

Monthly maintenance allowance: The fellowship's monthly allowance is set to €1040,98; the payment will be made to the fellow by wire transfer.

**Selection methods:** The selection will be carried out according to the following criteria: Individual interview, where competencies outlined in the Curriculum Vitae will be assessed, in conjunction with professional experience in the field and the motivation to be part of a team on an innovative project.

**Jury composition:** Isabel Pacheco Marques Vaz Marcos (President), Rui Manuel Pereira Coelho (Full member) e Helena Maria Laranjeira de Sousa (Full member).

**Announcement/ result notification:** All applicants will be notified by email.

**Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal**: A complaint may be lodged from the final decision, or an appeal to the President of IST, within 15 working days counted from the respective notification.

**Application deadline and formalization**: The call is open from September 1 until September 5, 2025.
