Scientific Initiation Studentships

Applications are open for 1 Scientific Initiation Studentships, within the framework of project Accelerate_FutureHEI (1018P.06262.1.01), financed by EU (Horizon Europe – WIDERA), under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Construction / Innovation and Entrepreneurship

Admission Requirements: To be enrolled at a master degree of Civil Engineering, Architecture, Engineering and Management, Engineering and Management of Innovation and Entrepreneurship, or be related to the proposed work plan;

Workplan: Support tasks of the Accelerate Future HEI Project for the acceleration and institutional transformation program for innovative and entrepreneurial higher education institutions.

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; IST Regulation of Scientific Research Fellowships, available on https://drh.tecnico.ulisboa.pt/files/sites/45/despacho 8532 regulamento bolsas.pdf

Workplace: The work will be developed at CERIS – Civil Engineering Research and Innovation for Sustainability of IST, under the scientific supervision of Prof. Nuno Almeida.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 6 months. It's expected to begin in October 2025, and may be eventually renewed up to the maximum of 12 months, including the duration of the initial contract.

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € €651,12, being the payment method by Wire Transfer.

Selection methods: The selection methods will be the following: Curriculum evaluation (50%), individual interview (50%). Preference for students fluent in the Portuguese language, in an advanced stage of their Master's program, with knowledge of the functioning of higher education institutions and/or experience with working in school units.

Composition of the selection Jury: Nuno Gonçalo Cordeiro Marques de Almeida, Inês dos Santos Flores Barbosa Colen, e António Morais Aguiar da Costa.

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from September 8 until September 12, 2025.

It is mandatory to formalize applications with the submission of the following documents: i) B1 Form — Fellowship application (http://drh.tecnico.ulisboa.pt/bolseiros/formularios/); ii) Curriculum Vitae; iii) academic degree certificate, where applicable; iv) proof of enrollment at an academic degree course or at a course that does not award an academic degree; v) motivation letter;
