Research Studentships (for PhD student)

Applications are open for one Research Studentship, within the framework of project R2UTechnologies, internal reference 1018P.06284, financed by the Recovery and Resilience Plan (PRR-IAPMEI), under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Construction

Admission Requirements: to be enrolled at a PhD degree integrated in the educational project of a higher education institution, performed in association or cooperation with one or several R&D units.

Workplan: Environmental and economic life cycle study of modular reinforced concrete constructions

Legislation and Regulations: Statute of Scientific Research Fellow, approved by Law nr. 40/2004, of August 18, as worded by Decree-Law nr. 123/2019, of August 28; https://dre.pt/application/file/a/127230968.

Workplace: The work will be developed at CERIS at IST (Lisbon), under the scientific supervision of Professor José Silvestre.

Duration: The research fellowship(s) will have the duration of 12 months. It's expected to begin in February 2025 and cannot be renewed.

Monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the monthly maintenance allowance is € 1259,64, being the payment method an option of the Fellow by Wire Transfer/Check.

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used will be as follows: curricular assessment (100%) carried out according to the following components: marks in courses already concluded in the PhD degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering or related areas and ranking of the University that teaches it (50%); experience in the field of construction sustainability (30%); experience in the preparation of scientific articles, published / accepted in international journals indexed by ISI / Scopus (10%); proficiency on the English language (10%). If an interview is held, in case of a tiebreaker, in this case the weighting will be 70% for the curricular evaluation and 30% for the interview. If none of the candidates has the appropriate profile, the scholarship will not be awarded.

Composition of the selection Jury: Professors José Dinis Silvestre, Maria da Glória Gomes and André Furtado

Announcement/ notification of the results: The final evaluation results will be communicated to all applicants by email.

Deadlines and procedures of complaint and appeal. A complaint may be lodged from the final decision within 15 working days, or an appeal to the Executive Board of IST within 30 working days, both counted from the respective notification

Application deadline and formalization: The call is open from January 8 until January 21, 2025
